The Irish Setter Club of Canada will conduct a licensed field trial for all pointing breeds near Hanna, AB on April 18 & 19, 2008. This trial is held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club, 400 – 200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke ON M9W5Z9.

Open Shooting Dog Stake	To follow upon completion of Open Derby Stake for dogs over 6 months of age.	\$50.00
Amateur Shooting Dog	Sunday, April 20, 2008, 7:30am for dogs over 6 months of age.	\$50.00
Open Puppy	To follow upon completion of the Amateur Shooting Dog Stake for dogs not over 18 months of age on April 20, 2008.	\$30.00

**Courses and Birds:** All courses will be single course. Released birds will be chukar and/or pheasant. Other native game birds may be present. No birds will be released for the puppy stake. In the event of adverse course conditions, the Field Trial Chairman may adjust the courses (including adding or deleting a bird field) to suit.

**Location:** The Club is grateful to have these grounds owned by Kenneth & Laureen Strellioff and James & Leah Hunter. A map showing the location of the grounds is attached to the premium list. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas. No smoking will be allowed beyond camp or on the back course.

**Accommodations:** Camping will be allowed on the grounds on Friday and Saturday nights and will be restricted to marked areas. Facilities are limited so please come prepared. **Food:** There will not be a concession at the trial. We will have a potluck dinner on Saturday evening and invite everyone to participate. Please bring lawn chairs.

**General Information:**

- Running and Handling: Horseback handling is optional in all stakes. If one handler is mounted and the other is walking, the judges shall set a reasonable pace.
- Handlers' horses will not be provided by the Club. Handlers will be responsible for making their own arrangements. The trial will not be held up waiting for horses at the line.
- Blank pistols only will be fired over all dogs with bird work in the senior and derby stakes. Blank pistols may be fired over puppies if both handlers agree. No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake. Pistols must have solid barrels
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours.
- The senior stakes will be 30 minutes in length, the derby stake will be 20-30 minutes in length and the puppy stake will be 20 minutes in length. The Club reserves the right to rearrange to running order of the junior stakes should conditions warrant.
- Collaring a dog away after game contact will be allowed.
- Bitches in season will not be permitted to run.
- Backing tests: If a dog has placed in one of the senior stakes of the Trial and needs only a backing test to complete the requirements for a Championship, the owner may request a backing test. This test will be allowed at the discretion of the Field Trial Chairman and will depend on the availability of birds. The test will cost \$20.00
- Tracking Collars: Electronic tracking collars may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Trial Chairman.

**It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind.**

**Reminder:** The ISCC wishes to remind all participants and spectators that there will be no exercising or training of any dogs on the grounds before, during, or after the trial. All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules & provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial rulebooks are available from the CKC or on-line at the CKC website for CKC members.

**Prizes:** Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to the placing dogs in all stakes.

Entries will close at 7:00 pm sharp on Tuesday, April 15, 2008 and the draw will be held at the home of Yvonne and Brian Norton.

**Entry fees** are to be paid in Canadian funds by cash, cheque or money order payable to the Irish Setter Club of Canada. The Field Trial Secretary will acknowledge the receipt of electronically transmitted entries. All entry forms are to be completed and in the hands of the Field Trial Secretary and entry fees paid in full prior to the running of a dog.

**Listing Fee:** A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is \$8.40 per dog per each event entered during the field trial and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries for this Field Trial are accepted on condition that the ISCC, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this Field Trial. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

**Map:** The field trial grounds are located 2 miles North of Hiway 9 on Range Road 16-1, then 1 mile East on Township Road 31-4, then 1 mile North on Range Road 16-0. The entrance to the grounds will be from Range Road 16-0.
